A	Submission of 25 multiple choice questions, true/false questions, histology/histopathology images with questions/year for IBTP examination (without repeatation) related to toxicology, clinical pathology, safety assessment, toxicologic pathology. (one point per question)	25	25
	Attend at least 5 hours lecture or webinar etc /year related to toxicology, clinical pathology, safety assessment, toxicologic pathology. (two point per hour)	10	10
	Proof on continuing practice of Toxicologic pathology (histopathology, clinical pathology, laboratory in-charge, teaching in toxicologic pathology). (two points per year)	10	10
	Scientific publication or poster presentation or case presentation or lecture given at IBTP/STPI or other national/international conferences OR being a panel member during the last 5 years (five points per event)	25	25
	Participation in STPI or other relevant symposiums/conferences, IBTP workshops attended (five points per event)	30	30
